## Key Action 1 – Mobility for learners and staff – Higher Education Student and Staff Mobility

### Inter-institutional agreement 2022-2028 between programme countries

The institutions named below agree to cooperate for the exchange of students and/or staff in the context of the Erasmus+ programme. They commit to respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects related to the organization and management of the mobility, in particular the recognition of the credits awarded to students by the partner institution.

### Educational Fields and Mobility Flows for Student and Staff Mobility covered by this Agreement

The parties to the present Interinstitutional agreement agree to cooperate in student and staff mobility in any of the education fields (broad, narrow and detailed) defined in the ISCED FIELDS OF EDUCATION AND TRAINING 2013 (ISCED-F 2013). Parties have identified common fields (see grid in Appendix 1)

Without prejudice to the previous paragraph, the student and staff mobility that is the object of this agreement will be carried out within the limits of the educational offering available at the home and host institutions. Additionally, the host University reserves the right to invoke formally established pre-requisites when determining the admission of candidates, as well as to set the limits of its own capacity to host students and staff of the partner Institution when determining the number of mobilities to be admitted, while taking into account the goal of a gradual increase in exchanges as agreed elsewhere by the partners, namely within the context of the approved European Universities project EUNICE 2020-2023.

The study and/or teaching and training programmes of the mobile students and staff will always be detailed in individual Learning Agreements, Teaching Agreements and Training Agreements, in accordance with the guidelines set out in the Erasmus Guide for Applicants, in its Sections covering Key Action 1 activities.





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
